Sixto-Clementine Vulgate According to James Hastings, "[t]he real reasons for the recall of the editions must have been partly personal hostility to Sixtus, and The Sixto-Clementine Vulgate or Clementine Vulgate (Latin: Vulgata Clementina) is an edition of the Latin Vulgate, the official Bible of the Roman Catholic Church.

The Sixto-Clementine Vulgate was used officially in the Catholic Church until 1979, when the Nova Vulgata was promulgated by Pope John Paul II. free of those. The Clementine Vulgate was promulgated in 1592 by Pope Clement VIII, hence its name. The Clementine Vulgate is still in use in the 1962 missal and breviary of the Catholic Church. It was the second edition of the Vulgate to be formally authorized by the Catholic Church, the first being the Sixtine Vulgate 23de26d169

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
