Most of the Japanese troops who were stationed in the Asia-Pacific region either took part in or did not oppose these crimes.

Its principal customers were ships' captains who purchased cargoes of coal and aimed to resell them in other parts of England; but above all in London which, by becoming the planet's first large mineral-fuelled city, had escaped a natural constraint on the growth of urban areas and was a voracious consumer of coal. Often dated 1771–1845, the Limitation of the Vend can be traced back much earlier
