In the 1890s, an increase in the rental income of property in the City of London led to a major expansion of the school, building on land it already owned at the eastern edge of Holt, including several new boarding houses as well as new teaching buildings, library, and chapel. eec1d87cee Priestley is credited with his independent discovery of oxygen by the thermal decomposition of mercuric oxide, having isolated it in 1774. During his lifetime, Priestley's considerable scientific reputation rested on his invention of carbonated water, his writings on electricity, and his discovery of several "airs" (gases), the most famous being what Priestley dubbed "dephlogisticated air" (oxygen).
