Linear amplifier Linearity refers to the ability of the amplifier to produce signals that are accurate copies of the input. Level 1. American Radio Relay A linear amplifier is an electronic circuit whose output is proportional to its input, but capable of delivering more power into a load. No amplifier can provide perfect linearity however, because the amplifying devices—transistors or vacuum tubes—follow nonlinear transfer function and rely on circuitry. The term usually refers to a type of radio-frequency (RF) power amplifier, some of which have output power measured in kilowatts, and are used in amateur radio. Technician. Continuous Tone-Coded Squelch System Where more than one group of users is on the same radio frequency (called co-channel users), CTCSS circuitry mutes those users who are using a different CTCSS tone or no CTCSS. It is sometimes referred to as tone squelch or PL for Private Line, a trademark of Motorola. It does this by adding a low frequency audio tone to the voice.
