Scanning electron microscope The electrons interact with atoms in the sample, producing various signals that contain information about the surface topography and composition. The electron beam is scanned in a raster scan pattern, and the position of the beam is combined with the intensity of the detected signal to produce an image. Metalloid Both form type III-V semiconductors (such as GaAs, AlSb or GaInAsSb) in which the average number of valence A metalloid is a chemical element which has a preponderance of properties in between, or that are a mixture of, those of metals and nonmetals. The word metalloid comes from the Latin metallum ("metal") and the Greek oeides ("resembling in form or appearance"). There is no standard definition of a metalloid and no complete agreement on which elements are metalloids. OFETs can be prepared either by vacuum evaporation of small molecules, by solution-casting of polymers or small An organic field-effect transistor (OFET) is a field-effect transistor using an organic semiconductor in its channel. using an organic semiconductor in its channel. OFETs have been fabricated with various device geometries. These devices have been developed to realize low-cost, large-area electronic products and biodegradable electronics. The most commonly used device geometry is bottom gate with top drain and source electrodes, because this geometry is similar to the thin-film silicon transistor (TFT) using thermally grown SiO2 as gate dielectric. OFETs can be prepared either by vacuum evaporation of small molecules, by solution-casting of polymers or small molecules, or by mechanical transfer of a peeled single-crystalline organic layer onto a substrate 564d9399e3
