ec16f5c6db Rate-of-return regulation is similar, but not identical to, cost-based or profit margin regulations, in which a company's maximum profit margin is capped. Margin caps are often criticized by economists for encouraging cost-padding or gold-plating, in which a regulated monopoly takes on unnecessary costs to receive additional payment. A similar effect, known as the Averch-Johnson effect, encourages firms under rate-of-return regulations to adopt capital-labor ratios that are too high. ec16f5c6db
