Metalloid The word metalloid comes from the Latin metallum ("metal") and the Greek oeides ("resembling in form or appearance"). There is no standard definition of a metalloid and no complete agreement on which elements are metalloids. MSDS Archived Lawsone (2-hydroxy-1,4-naphthoquinone), also known as hennotannic acid, is a red-orange dye present in the leaves of the henna plant (*Lawsonia inermis*), for which it is named, as well as in the common walnut (*Juglans regia*) and water hyacinth (*Pontederia crassipes*). Lawsone strongly absorbs UV light, and aqueous extracts can be effective sunless. Darker colored staining is due to more lawsone-keratin interactions occurring, which evidently break down as the concentration of lawsone decreases and the tattoo fades. isomer used as a brown dye. Atovaquone is a synthetic antimicrobial agent that can be manufactured from lawsone. Lawsone reacts chemically with the protein keratin in skin and hair via a Michael addition reaction, resulting in a strong permanent stain that lasts until the skin or hair is shed 2a9afb3fbf
