Applied sociological research may be applied directly to social policy and welfare, whereas theoretical approaches may focus. Regarded as a part of both the social sciences and humanities, sociology uses various methods of empirical investigation and critical analysis to develop a body of knowledge about social order and social change e4e0a2b8d3

Transmission electron microscopy An image is formed from the interaction of the electrons with the sample as the beam is transmitted through the specimen. The image is then magnified and focused onto an imaging device, such as a fluorescent screen, a layer of photographic film, or a detector such as a scintillator attached to a charge-coupled device or a direct electron detector. The specimen is most often an ultrathin section less than 100 nm thick or a
