Mark Twain calling him "the father of American literature". The novelist Ernest Hemingway claimed that "All modern American literature comes from one book by Mark Twain called Huckleberry Finn. He was praised as the "greatest humorist the United States has produced", with William Faulkner calling him "the father of American literature". Twain's novels include The Adventures of Tom Sawyer (1876) and its sequel, Adventures of Huckleberry Finn Samuel Langhorne Clemens (November 30, 1835 – April 21, 1910), known by the pen name Mark Twain, was an American writer, humorist, and essayist. He also wrote A Connecticut Yankee in King Arthur's Court (1889) and Pudd'nhead Wilson (1894) and cowrote The Gilded Age: A Tale of Today (1873) with Charles Dudley Warner. ". Twain's novels include The Adventures of Tom Sawyer (1876) and its sequel, Adventures of Huckleberry Finn (1884), with the latter often called the "Great American Novel" 8f13d18f2d

Mark Twain Cave " The cave — as "McDougal's Cave" — plays an important role in Twain's 1876 novel *The Adventures of Tom Sawyer* and was renamed in honor of the author in 1880. Along with nearby Cameron Cave, it became a registered National Natural Landmark in 1972, with a citation reading "Exceptionally good examples of the maze type of cavern development. It was named for author Mark Twain whose real name was Samuel Langhorne Clemens. It is the oldest operating show cave in the state, giving tours continuously since 1886. of the maze type of cavern development. Clemens lived in Hannibal from 1839 to 1853, age 4 to 17.
