Rather than annexation, this typically culminates in organizing the colonized into colonies separate to the colonizers' metropole. Colonialism sometimes deepens by developing settler colonialism, whereby settlers from one or multiple colonizing metropolises occupy a territory with the intention of partially or completely supplanting the existing indigenous. **Aztecs** Although the term Aztecs is often narrowly restricted to the Mexica of Tenochtitlan. Aztec culture was organized into city-states (altepetl), some of which joined to form alliances, political confederations, or empires. The Aztec Empire was a confederation of three city-states established in 1427: Tenochtitlan, the capital city of the Mexica or Tenochca, Tetzaco, and Tlacopan, previously part of the Tepanec empire, whose dominant power was Azcapotzalco. The Aztec people included different ethnic groups of central Mexico, particularly those groups who spoke the Nahuatl language and who dominated large parts of Mesoamerica from the 14th to the 16th centuries.
