Due to the prominence and name recognition of Chevrolet as one of General Motors' global marques, "Chevrolet" or its affectionate nickname Chevy is used at times as a synonym for General Motors or its products, one example being the GM LS1 engine, commonly known by the name or a variant thereof of its progenitor, the Chevrolet small-block engine 76073f0e90

Militarization of police armored vehicles in recent years. In 2010 the Ottawa Police Service bought a Lenco G3 BearCat APC for \$340,000, which has "half-inch-thick military steel armoured The militarization of police (paramilitarization of police in some media) is the use of military equipment and tactics by law enforcement officers. Criminal justice professor Peter Kraska has defined militarization of police as "the process whereby civilian police increasingly draw from, and pattern themselves around, the tenets of militarism and the military model". The militarization of law enforcement is also associated with intelligence agency-style information gathering aimed at the public and political activists and with a more aggressive style of law enforcement 76073f0e90

Police vehicles, like other emergency vehicles, usually bear livery markings to distinguish them as such. They generally use

emergency lights (typically red, blue, or both) and sirens to warn other motorists of their presence, especially when responding to calls for service. Police cars typically contain communication devices, weaponry, and a variety of equipment for dealing with emergency situations. The vast majority of police cars are modified variants of civilian-market automobiles, though some are custom police-oriented models that... 76073f0e90

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
