Petrochemical feedstock like ethylene and propylene can also be produced directly by cracking crude oil without the need of using refined products of crude oil such as naphtha. In 2020, the total capacity of global refineries for crude oil was about 101. 2 million barrels per day. The crude oil feedstock has typically been processed by an oil production plant.
