Translanguaging However, emphasizing language learning as a means to enter a discourse community was also problematic Translanguaging is a term that can refer to different aspects of multilingualism. The term "translanguaging" was coined in the 1980s by Cen Williams (applied in Welsh as trawsieithu) in his unpublished thesis titled "An Evaluation of Teaching and Learning Methods in the Context of Bilingual Secondary Education". It can also refer to a pedagogical approach that utilizes more than one language within a classroom

lesson. Williams used the term to describe the practice of using two languages in the same lesson, which differed from many previous methods of bilingual education that tried to separate languages by class, time, or day. participation in particular discourse communities. meaning "will buy", derived from the verb acheter ("to buy"). The "future" expressed by the future tense usually means the future relative to the moment of speaking, although in contexts where relative tense is used it may mean the future relative to some other point in time under consideration 38255f3c9a

English as a lingua franca English became the established global lingua franca in academia after the 1940s (until which French and German were of equal importance) and, by the end English as a lingua franca (ELF) is the use of the English language "as a global means of inter-community communication" and can be understood as "any use of English among speakers of different first languages for whom English is the communicative medium of choice and often the only option". ELF is "defined functionally by its use in intercultural communication rather than formally by its reference to native-speaker norms" whereas English as a second or foreign language aims at meeting native speaker norms and gives prominence to native-speaker cultural aspects 38255f3c9a

Grammatical mood). The term is also used more broadly to describe the syntactic expression of modality – that is, the use of verb phrases that do not involve inflection of the verb itself. Articles In linguistics, grammatical mood is a grammatical feature of verbs, used for signaling modality. Each of these markers is used in conjunction with the subject proclitics except for the aa marker.
