The practice entails the targeted removal of diseased, damaged, dead, non-productive, structurally unsound, or otherwise unwanted plant material from crop and landscape plants. In general, the smaller the branch that is cut, the easier it is for a woody plant to compartmentalize the wound and thus limit the potential for pathogen intrusion and decay. It is therefore preferable to make any necessary formative structural pruning cuts to young plants, rather than removing large, poorly placed branches from mature plants. 656bfb1b4b Woody plants may undergo a process referred to as self-pruning, where they will drop... 656bfb1b4b

Arboriculture The science of arboriculture studies how these plants grow and respond. Arboriculture (, from Latin: arboris + culture) is the cultivation, management, and study of individual trees, shrubs, vines, and other perennial woody plants. Defensible space (fire control) Shrubs should be A defensible space, in the context of fire control, is a natural or landscaped area around a structure that has been maintained and designed to reduce fire danger. (10 cm). Firefighters sometimes do not attempt to protect structures without adequate defensible space, as it is less safe and less likely to succeed. "Defensible space" is also used in the context of wildfires, especially in the wildland-urban interface (WUI). Trees should be 10 feet away from each other on a flat to mild slope but should be double that on a mild to moderate slope. This defensible space reduces the risk that fire will spread from one area to another, or to a structure, and provides firefighters access and a safer area from which to defend a threatened area. The practice is sometimes called firescaping 656bfb1b4b

Arborists generally focus on the health and safety of individual plants and trees, rather than managing forests or harvesting wood (silviculture or forestry). An

arborist's scope of work is therefore distinct from that of either a forester or a logger. 656bfb1b4b Arthur's Osborn's father, Brewer Osborn, gained a considerable reputation as a horticulturalist and was a gardener at Holme Park, Sonning from 656bfb1b4b

It includes the following parts: Pruning Soil management Supplemental Tree care is the application of arboricultural methods like pruning, trimming, and felling/thinning in built environments. High safety standards against the dangers of tree care have helped the industry evolve. Especially felling in space-limited environments poses significant risks: the vicinity of power or telephone lines, insufficient protective gear (against falling dead wood, chainsaw wounds, etc.) and narrow felling zones with endangered nearby buildings, parking cars, etc. Road verge, greenways, backyard and park woody vegetation are at the center of attention for the tree care industry. Landscape architecture and urban forestry also set high demands on professional tree care. The required equipment and experience usually transcends private means and is often considered too costly as 656bfb1b4b

1870 to 1898. In 1899 Arthur Osborn became a gardener at the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew. At the Kew Arboretum he was appointed an assistant curator and was eventually promoted to deputy curator. He was in charge of the Kew Arboretum during the 1930s. His 1933 book *Shrubs and Trees for the Garden* showed his "extensive practical experience in arboriculture". 656bfb1b4b

Others in such species have the potential... 656bfb1b4b PlantAmnesty was founded by arborist Cass Turnbull on October 22, 1987, as a mock protest group intended to educate the public about the problems associated with pruning techniques which are biologically harmful to plants and counter productive to the goals of landscape design and management; most notably tree topping. The stated mission of the organization "is to end the senseless torture and mutilation of trees and shrubs."

PlantAmnesty also provides an "adopt-a-plant" exchange for unwanted, healthy plants. 656bfb1b4b It is practiced in horticulture (especially fruit tree pruning), arboriculture, and silviculture. 656bfb1b4b

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
