Although Circumcision is a surgical procedure that removes the foreskin from the human penis. Topical or locally injected anesthesia is generally used to reduce pain and physiologic stress. In the most common form of the operation, the foreskin is extended with forceps, then a circumcision device may be placed, after which the foreskin is excised.
