Tacit programming A sequence of operations such as the following: `def example(x): return baz(bar(foo(x)))` Tacit programming, also called point-free style, is a programming paradigm in which function definitions do not identify the arguments (or "points") on which they operate. Tacit programming is of theoretical interest, because the strict use of composition results in programs that are well adapted for equational reasoning. The lack of argument naming gives point-free style a reputation of being needlessly obscure, hence the epithet "pointless style". Instead the definitions merely compose other functions, among which are combinators that manipulate the arguments. pipes.
