In aircraft in which the flight control system is fly-by-wire, the movements the pilot makes to the yoke or joystick in the cockpit, to control the flight, are converted to electronic signals, which are transmitted to the flight control computers that determine how to move each control surface to provide the aircraft movement the pilot ordered. All 387 aircraft delivered to airlines were grounded by March 18. By March 13, the FAA followed behind 51 concerned regulators in deciding to ground the aircraft. The Federal Aviation Administration initially affirmed the MAX's continued airworthiness, claiming to have insufficient evidence of accident similarities 3128dab957
