By 1818, Barings was called "the sixth great European power", after England, France, Prussia, Austria and Russia. Due to a fall-off in business and some poor leadership, Barings ceded dominance in the City of London to the rival firm of N M Rothschild & Sons in the 1820s but remained heavily involved in the slave-powered economy through its investments in cotton and trading in slave-based mortgages.
