". As he continued writing lyric poetry, Williams spent increasing amounts of time on Paterson, honing his approach to it both in terms of style and structure. Dead space (physiology) by: Using separate intake and exhaust passages with one-way valves placed in each passage, usually between each passage and the mouthpiece. This limits Dead space is the volume of air that is inhaled that does not take part in the gas exchange, because it either remains in the conducting airways or reaches alveoli that are not perfused or poorly perfused. Mammals breathe in and out of their lungs, wasting that part of the inhalation which remains in the conducting airways where no gas exchange can occur. It means that not all the air in each breath is available for the exchange of oxygen and carbon dioxide d32cb0496c
