The council was attended by over 520 bishops or their representatives, making it the largest and best-documented of the first seven ecumenical councils. Such doctrines viewed Christ's divine and human natures as separate and distinct (Nestorianism), or viewed Christ as solely divine (monophysitism). It was convoked by the Roman emperor Marcian.
