Maternal death The CDC definition of pregnancy-related deaths extends the period of consideration to include one year from the resolution of the pregnancy. This can occur either while she is pregnant or within six weeks of resolution of the pregnancy. Pregnancy associated death, as defined by the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists (ACOG), are all deaths occurring within one year of a pregnancy resolution. The World Health Organization (WHO) defines maternal death as the death of a pregnant mother due to complications related to pregnancy, underlying conditions worsened by the pregnancy or management of these conditions. abortion practices can cause significant rates of maternal death. Identification of pregnancy associated deaths is important. Such measures have included: Minimum required reserve ratios (RRRs) Minimum capital ratios Government bond deposit requirements for note issue 100% Fractional-reserve banking is the system of banking in all countries worldwide, under which banks that take deposits from the public keep only part of their deposit liabilities in liquid assets as a reserve, typically lending the remainder to borrowers. Fractional-reserve banking differs from the hypothetical alternative model, full-reserve banking, in which banks would keep all depositor funds on hand as reserves debb84d4f3

Literacy rate in urban areas was 90%, higher than rural areas with 77%. Interest rates reflect a borrower's willingness to pay for money now over money in the future. In debt financing, companies borrow capital from a bank, in the expectation that the borrowed capital may be used to generate a return on investment greater than the interest rates. Failure of a borrower to continue paying interest is an example of default, which may be followed by bankruptcy proceedings. Collateral is sometimes given in the event of default.
