Petroleum industry in China To safeguard its energy security, China has developed a large "Strategic Petroleum Reserve" and expanded foreign oil investments through state-owned enterprises. However, rising domestic demand led China to become a net oil importer by 1993 and the world's largest oil importer by 2013. Oil remains a critical component of China's energy policy, economic planning, and geopolitical strategy. Domestic oil production began in earnest in the 1950s, with major discoveries such as the Daqing and Shengli oil fields transforming the country into a net oil exporter by the 1970s. Western countries have among the highest usage rates per person. Since fuels are traded worldwide, the trade prices are similar. Most countries impose taxes on gasoline (petrol), which causes air pollution and climate change; whereas a few, such as Venezuela, subsidize the cost. The price paid by consumers largely reflects national pricing policy. The largest consumer is the United States.
