These concerns however can be careful managed, especially because most of this mining would occur below Biomining refers to any process that uses living organisms to extract metals from ores and other solid materials. The largest application currently being used is the treatment of mining waste containing iron, copper, zinc, and gold allowing for salvation of any discarded minerals. Typically these processes involve prokaryotes, however fungi and plants (phytoextraction also known as phytomining) may also be used. Biomining is one of several applications within biohydrometallurgy with applications in ore refinement, precious metal recovery, and bioremediation.
