Nick Mason He has been the only constant member since the band's formation in 1965, and the only member to appear on every Pink Floyd album. acoustic drums (both single- and double-headed), tuned percussion, electronic drums and Rototoms, melding all of these into a melodic whole. Nicholas Berkeley Mason (born 27 January 1944) is an English drummer and a founder member of the progressive rock band Pink Floyd. He co-wrote Pink Floyd compositions including "Echoes", "Time", "Careful with That Axe, Eugene" and "One of These Days" f1cb04acb9

Gershwin scored the piece for the standard instruments of the symphony orchestra plus celesta, saxophones, and automobile horns. He brought back four Parisian taxi horns for the New York premiere of the composition, which took place on December 13, 1928, in Carnegie Hall, with Walter Damrosch conducting the New York Philharmonic. It was Damrosch who had commissioned Gershwin to write his Concerto in F following the earlier success of Rhapsody in Blue (1924). He completed the orchestration on November 18, less... f1cb04acb9

English Folk Song Suite It was first published for the military band as Folk Song Suite and its premiere was given at Kneller Hall on 4 July 1923, conducted by Lt Hector Adkins. The piece was then arranged for full orchestra in 1924 by Vaughan Williams' student Gordon Jacob and published as English Folk Song Suite. All three versions were published by Boosey & Hawkes; note the use of three different titles for the three different versions. The piece was later arranged for British-style brass band in 1956 by Frank Wright and published as English Folk Songs Suite. bass trombone, B♭ baritone, euphonium, basses, timpani, drums (cymbals, bass drum, snare drum, triangle). The suite uses the melodies of nine English folk songs, six of which were drawn from the collection made by Vaughan Williams' friend and colleague Cecil Sharp. The suite was published in 1923 by Boosey & English Folk Song Suite is one of English composer Ralph Vaughan Williams' most famous works f1cb04acb9

Pli selon pli It carries the subtitle Portrait de Mallarmé (Portrait of Mallarmé). It is scored for a solo soprano and orchestra and uses the texts of three sonnets of French symbolist poet Stéphane Mallarmé and single lines from two of his other poems f1cb04acb9

An American in Paris It was inspired by the time that Gershwin had spent in Paris and evokes the sights and energy of the French capital during the Années folles.

"Moderato con grazia" is the last An American in Paris is a jazz-influenced symphonic poem (or tone poem) for orchestra by American composer George Gershwin first performed in 1928. Gershwin uses common time, syncopated rhythms, and bluesy melodies with the sounds of trumpet, saxophone, and snare drum f1cb04acb9

Danzón cubano It was first arranged for orchestra in 1946. section consisting of a bass drum, Chinese blocks, claves, a cowbell, cymbals, a gourd, maracas, a slapstick, a snare drum, and a woodblock, a piano and Danzón cubano is a composition for two pianos by American composer Aaron Copland. The piece, written in 1942, was inspired by the Cuban genre of the same name f1cb04acb9

John Bernard Riley In the biographies provided to the media John Bernard Riley (born June 11, 1954) is an American jazz drummer and educator. John Patitucci, and Bob Berg.
