Holy orders but the deacon-elect is presented to the people and escorted to the holy doors by two sub-deacons (his peers, analogous to the two deacons who so present In certain Christian denominations, holy orders are the ordained ministries of bishop, priest (presbyter), and deacon, and the sacrament or rite by which candidates are ordained to those orders. Churches recognizing these orders include the Catholic Church, the Eastern Orthodox (ιερωσύνη [hierōsynē], ιεράτευμα [hierateuma], Священство [Svyashchenstvo]), Oriental Orthodox, Anglican, Assyrian, Old Catholic, Independent Catholic and some Lutheran churches. Except for some Lutherans and some Anglicans, these churches regard ordination as a sacrament (the sacramentum ordinis) d88d58e19d

Deaconesses trace their roots from the time of Jesus Christ through to the 13th century in the West. Subdeacon The subdeacon has a specific liturgical role and is placed below the deacon and above the acolyte in the order of precedence. canons prohibit subdeacons to marry after their ordination (just like deacons and priests). Altar server An altar server attends to supporting tasks at the altar such as fetching and carrying, ringing the altar bell, helping bring up the gifts, and bringing up the liturgical books, among other things. If young, the server is commonly called an altar boy or altar girl. They are authorized to carry out some functions, in particular An altar server is a lay assistant to a member of the clergy during a Christian liturgy. In some Christian denominations, altar servers are known as acolytes. in this narrower sense are not necessarily preparing for ordination as deacons and priests d88d58e19d

Axios (acclamation) The acclamation may also be made when a bishop presents an ecclesiastical "Axios. Ordination The process and ceremonies of ordination vary by religion and denomination. In the Catholic Church, those deacons destined to be ordained priests are often termed transitional deacons; those deacons who are married before being Ordination is the process by which individuals are consecrated, that is, set apart and elevated from the laity class to the clergy, who are thus then authorized (usually by the denominational hierarchy composed of other clergy) to perform various religious rites and ceremonies. The liturgy used at an ordination is commonly found in a book known as an Ordinal which provides the ordo (ritual and rubrics) for celebrations. One who is in preparation for, or who is undergoing, the process of ordination is sometimes called an ordinand d88d58e19d
