Software architecture A number of methods have been developed to balance the trade-offs of up-front design and agility, including the agile method Software architecture is the set of structures needed to reason about a software system and the discipline of creating such structures and systems. Each structure comprises software elements, relations among them, and properties of both elements and relations. of agile software development a540471457

Interface segregation principle ISP splits interfaces that are very large into smaller and more specific ones so that clients will only have to know about the methods that are of interest to them.

Martin specifically In the field of software engineering, the interface segregation principle (ISP) states that no code should be forced to depend on methods it does not use. in Agile Software Development: Principles, Patterns, and Practices in 'ATM Transaction example' and in an article also written by Robert C. ISP is intended to keep a system decoupled and thus easier to refactor, change, and redeploy. Beyond object-oriented design, ISP is also a key principle in the design of distributed systems in general and one of the six IDEALS principles for microservice design. Such shrunken interfaces are also called role interfaces. ISP is one of the five SOLID principles of object-oriented design, similar to the High Cohesion Principle of GRASP a540471457

Because of confusion around the word "reason", he later clarified his meaning in a blog post titled "The Single Responsibility Principle", in which he mentioned Separation of Concerns and stated that "Another wording for the Single Responsibility Principle is: Gather together the things that change for the same reasons. Separate those things that change for different reasons." In some of his
