Failure mode and effects analysis A FMEA can be a qualitative analysis, but may be put on a semi-quantitative basis with an RPN model. For each component, the failure modes and their resulting effects on the rest of the system are recorded in a specific FMEA worksheet. It was one of the first highly structured, systematic techniques for failure analysis. Related methods combine mathematical failure rate models with a statistical failure mode ratio databases. The FME(C)A is Failure mode and effects analysis (FMEA; often written with "failure modes" in plural) is the process of reviewing as many components, assemblies, and subsystems as possible to identify potential failure modes in a system and their causes and effects. It was developed by reliability engineers in the late 1950s to study. information on causes of failure (deductive analysis) to reduce the possibility of occurrence by eliminating identified (root) causes. Delphi The name Delphi comes from the same root as δελφύς delphys, "womb" and may indicate archaic Delphi (; Greek: Δελφοί [ðel'fi]), in legend previously called Pytho (Πυθώ), was an ancient sacred precinct and the seat of Pythia, the major oracle who was consulted about important decisions throughout the ancient classical world. Dorian Shainin In the 1940s Leonard Seder, an MIT classmate and friend, developed the Multi-vari chart, a graphical method for analysis of Dorian Shainin (September 26, 1914 – January 7, 2000) was an American quality consultant, aeronautics engineer, author, and college professor most notable for his contributions in the fields of industrial problem solving, product reliability, and quality engineering, particularly the creation and development of the "Red X" concept. the root cause, or "Red X"

According to the Suda, Delphi took its name from the Delphyne, the she-serpent (drakaina) who lived there and was killed by the god Apollo (in other accounts the serpent was the male serpent (drakon) Python). In Hellenistic-era Asia Minor, Avestan Mithra was conflated with various local and Greek figures leading to several different variants of Apollo-Helios-Mithras-Hermes-Stilbon. Maitreya, a vrddhi-derived form of Sanskrit mitra, a bodhisattva in Buddhist tradition.

Mitra "that which causes to think"; (also found in man-tra-, "that which causes to think"), then literally Mitra (Proto-Indo-Iranian: *mitrás) is the name of an Indo-Iranian divinity that predates the Rigvedic Mitrá and Avestan Mithra. Combining the root *mei with the "tool suffix" -tra- "that which [causes]. bind"
