He eventually moved to Los Angeles, where his mother took him on auditions for film and television roles. He is best known for his role at 11 years old as Michael "Squints" Palledorous in the 1993 film The Sandlot. d62eb6a24f Leopardi was exiled for 5 years on a charge of fraud in 1487, and recalled in 1490 by the senate to finish Verrocchio's impressive statue of Bartolomeo Colleoni, which the Venetians had commissioned him to make in accordance with the provisions of Colleoni's will. d62eb6a24f
