Machine The term is commonly applied to artificial devices, such as those employing engines or motors, but also to natural biological macromolecules, such as molecular machines. fabrication and uses. Machines can be driven by animals and people, by natural forces such as wind and water, and by chemical, thermal, or electrical power, and include a system of mechanisms that shape the actuator input to achieve a specific application of output

However, the Greeks' understanding was limited to statics (the balance of forces) and did not include dynamics (the tradeoff between A machine is a physical system that uses power to apply forces and control movement to perform an action. They can also include computers and sensors that monitor performance and plan movement, often called mechanical systems

Mechanical engineering typically use mechanics in the design or analysis phases of engineering. It is one of the oldest and broadest of the engineering branches. If the engineering project were the design of a vehicle, statics might be employed Mechanical engineering is the study of physical machines and mechanisms that may involve force and movement. It is an engineering branch that combines engineering physics and mathematics principles with materials science, to design, analyze, manufacture, and maintain mechanical systems

The earliest roots of scientific thinking and practice can be traced to Ancient Egypt and Mesopotamia during the 3rd and 2nd millennia BCE. These civilizations' contributions to mathematics, astronomy, and medicine influenced later Greek natural philosophy of classical antiquity, wherein formal attempts were made to provide explanations... Italians also contributed in theorizing civil law, scientific method (particularly in the fields of physics and astronomy), double-entry bookkeeping, mathematical algebra and analysis, classical

and celestial mechanics.
