Travel health nursing Travel nursing has experienced an increase in global demand due to the evolution of travel medicine. Travel nursing is a nursing specialty which promotes the health and safety of national and international travelers. Travel health nursing was recognized during the 1980s as an emerging occupation to meet the needs of the traveling public, and additional education and training was established. Travel health nurses typically work in "private practice, hospital outpatient units, universities, the government, and the military", and have more opportunities and leadership roles as travel has become more common. Reflective practice This leads to developmental insight". According to one definition it involves "paying critical attention to the practical values and theories which inform everyday actions, by examining practice reflectively and reflexively. practice is taking a conscious look at emotions, experiences, actions, and responses, and using that information to add to one's existing knowledge base Reflective practice is the ability to reflect on one's actions so as to take a critical stance or

attitude towards one's own practice and that of one's peers, engaging in a process of continuous adaptation and learning. A key rationale for reflective practice is that experience alone does not necessarily lead to learning; deliberate reflection on experience is essential 754a3ab58c
