Coalescent theory In the simplest case, coalescent theory assumes no recombination, no natural selection, and no gene flow or population structure, meaning that each variant is equally likely to have been passed from one generation to the next. Variance in the model comes from both the random passing of alleles from one generation to the next, and the random occurrence of mutations in these alleles. The mathematical theory of the coalescent was developed Coalescent theory is a model of how alleles sampled from a population may have originated from a common ancestor. The model looks backward in time, merging alleles into a single ancestral copy according to a random process in coalescence events.
