Crusades of the 15th century In May 1480, Mehmed II dispatched Crusades of the 15th century are those Crusades that follow the Crusades after Acre, 1291-1399, throughout the next hundred years. Rhodes was conducted in 1480. In addition, the Reconquista was completed and heretics continued to be suppressed. Pierre d'Aubusson was Grand Master at that time and a zealous enemy of the Ottoman Empire. The Ottomans gained significant territory in all theaters, but did not defeat Hospitaller Rhodes nor advance past the Balkans. In this time period, the threat from the

Ottoman Empire dominated the Christian world, but also included threats from the Mamluks, Moors, and heretics

The fall of Constantinople in 1453 marked the end of the Byzantine Empire, and the Teutonic Knights were spent as a fighting force. The crusades would continue for almost another 100 years, with the expansion of the Ottoman Empire to a level that lasted into the 20th century.
