Societal and cultural aspects of autism The autistic community is divided primarily into two camps: the autism rights movement and the pathology paradigm. Visual thinking Visual thinking has been described as seeing words as a series of pictures. Research by child development theorist Linda Kreger Silverman suggests that less than 30% of the population strongly uses visual/spatial thinking, another 45% uses both visual/spatial thinking and thinking in the form of words, and 25% thinks exclusively in words. "Real picture thinkers", those who use visual thinking almost to the exclusion of other kinds of thinking, make up a smaller percentage of the population. Concepts related to visual thinking have played an important role Visual thinking, also called visual or spatial learning or picture thinking, is the phenomenon of thinking through visual processing. It is common in approximately 60–65% of the general population. According to Kreger Silverman, of the 30% of the general population who use visual/spatial thinking, only a. the existence of people with both Aphantasia and autism brings this theory into question 93461e7573
