Monsters in Dungeons & Dragons As an essential part of Dungeons & Dragons, many of its monsters have become iconic and recognizable even outside D&D, becoming influential in video games, fiction, and. Beginning with the first edition in 1974, a catalog of game monsters (bestiary) was included along with other game manuals, first called *Monsters & Treasure* and now called the *Monster Manual*. Included are traditional monsters such as dragons, supernatural creatures such as ghosts, and mundane or fantastic animals.
