Most pencil cores are made of graphite powder mixed with a clay binder. In contrast to the low burnup of weeks or months that is commonly required to produce weapons-grade plutonium ($\text{WGPu}/^{239}\text{Pu}$), the long time in the reactor that produces reactor-grade plutonium leads to transmutation of much of the fissile, relatively long half-life isotope ^{239}Pu into a number of other isotopes of plutonium that are less fissile or more radioactive. When ^{239}Pu absorbs a neutron, it does not always undergo nuclear fission.
