Two red links remain: Waelulu, whose existence could not be confirmed in a 1989 SIL survey of west Seram (though another language unconfirmed in that survey, Jahalatane, is now known to exist), and Holima, which had not appeared in the previous edition of Ethnologue and was described as being "near Dobu".
