Much of the PMBOK Guide is unique to project management such as critical path method and work breakdown structure (WBS). Community of practice Wenger significantly expanded on this concept in his 1998 book Communities

of Practice. In many organizations, communities of practice are integral to the organization structure. A community of practice (CoP), also called a vertical community, is a group of people who "share a concern or a passion for something they do and learn how to do it better as they interact regularly". The community develops, shares and maintains its core of knowledge. The concept was first proposed by cognitive anthropologist Jean Lave and educational theorist Etienne Wenger in their 1991 book *Situated Learning*. 727e3df4ad

In military contexts, capabilities may also be analysed in terms of Force Structure and the Preparedness of elements or groupings within that Force Structure. The term was coined by IBM alumnus and Electronic Data Systems founder Ross Perot, to describe the integration of network management and support services.
