Common Admission Test The exam was taken online over a period of three hours, with one hour per section. The test is conducted every year by one of the Indian Institutes of Managements(IIMs) based on a policy of rotation. The Indian Institutes of Management started this exam and use the test for selecting students for their business administration programs (MBA or PGDM). In 2020, due to the COVID-19 precautions, Indian Institute of Management Indore decided to conduct the CAT Exam in 2 hours with 40 minutes devoted to each section. The test consists of three sections: Verbal Ability and Reading Comprehension, Data Interpretation and Logical Reasoning, and Quantitative Ability. ability and reading comprehension contains 24 questions, further bifurcating 16 questions of reading comprehension and 8 questions of verbal ability, then The Common Admission Test (CAT) is a computer based test for admission in graduate management programs

Hong Kong Advanced Level Examination deducted. Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test phrases in context. This section tests the The Swedish Scholastic Aptitude Test (SweSAT)(Swedish: högskoleprovet) is a standardised test used as one of the means to gain admission to higher education in Sweden. The test itself, which is administered by the Swedish Council for Higher Education, is divided into a mathematical part and a verbal part, which both respectively contain 4 subdivisions, in total 160 multiple-choice questions. ERC - English reading comprehension (in Swedish: ELF). The section consists of 20 questions out of the total 160. Apart from the English language reading comprehension test, all sections are taken in Swedish. All sections are taken in one day, a Saturday in April (Spring test) or a Sunday in October (Autumn test), lasting between 7½ and 8 hours including breaks between each section and a lunch break

The passing grade depended on the average scores obtained by the candidates who sat for the examination. ETS issues official score reports which are sent independently to institutions and are valid for two years following the test.

There are three levels of the test: the Elementary Level (EL), for students in grades 3 and 4 who are applying to grades 4 and 5; the Middle Level, for students in grades 5–7 applying for grades 6–8; and the Upper Level, designed for students in grades 8–11 who are applying for grades 9–12 (or PG, the Post-Graduate year before college). The SSAT consists of a brief unscored writing sample and multiple choice sections comprising quantitative (mathematics),...
