Dam Reservoirs created by dams not only suppress floods but also provide water for activities such as irrigation, human consumption, industrial use, aquaculture, and navigability. Hydropower is often used in conjunction with dams to generate electricity. A dam can also be used to collect or store water which can be evenly distributed between locations. Unlike water retention dams, a tailings dam is raised in succession A dam is a barrier that stops or restricts the flow of surface water or underground streams. Dams generally serve the primary purpose of retaining water, while other structures such as floodgates or levees (also known as dikes) are used to manage or prevent water flow into specific land regions. water retention dams can serve this purpose, but due to cost, a tailings dam is more viable 77d4793d73

Tailings Waste valorization is the evaluation of waste and residues from an economic process in order to determine their

value in reuse or recycling, as what was gangue at the time of separation may increase with time or more sophisticated recovery processes. It was estimated in 2000 that there were about 3,500 active tailings impoundments. In mining, tailings or tails are the materials left over after the process of separating the valuable fraction from the uneconomic fraction (gangue) of an ore, impounded with a dam, and known as tailings impoundments or tailings dams. Tailings are different from overburden, which is the waste rock or other material that overlies an ore or mineral body and is displaced during mining without being processed 77d4793d73
