= $9a^2 + 9a^2x + 9a^2x^2$ The values of x that satisfy the equation are called solutions...

$\{ \displaystyle ax^2+bx+c=0 \}$ where the variable x represents an unknown number, and a , b , and c represent known numbers, where $a \neq 0$. (If $a = 0$ and $b \neq 0$ then the equation is linear, not quadratic.) The numbers a , b , and c are the coefficients of the equation and may be distinguished by respectively calling them, the quadratic coefficient, the linear coefficient and the constant coefficient or free term. $2a^2 + 0b + 9a^2$, $9a^2x + 9a^2x^2$
