The main poverty line used in the OECD and the European Union is a relative poverty measure based on 60% of the median household income. In addition to commonly reported direct violence, structural Environmental defenders or environmental human rights defenders are individuals or collectives who protect the environment from harms resulting from resource extraction, hazardous waste disposal, infrastructure projects, land appropriation, or other dangers. Use of the term is contested, as it homogenizes such a wide range of groups and campaigns, many of whom do not self-identify with the term and may not have explicit aims to protect the environment (being motivated primarily by social justice concerns 2d9f48cb6d
