Traditional examples of designs are architectural and engineering drawings, circuit diagrams, sewing patterns, and less tangible. In Western A design is the concept or proposal for an object, process, or system. The verb to design expresses the process of developing a design. influential design historians include German-British art historian Nikolaus Pevsner and Swiss historian and architecture critic Sigfried Giedion. A design is expected to have a purpose within a specific context, typically aiming to satisfy certain goals and constraints while taking into account aesthetic, functional and experiential considerations. In some cases, the direct construction of an object without an explicit prior plan may also be considered to be a design (such as in arts and crafts)
