Reading comprehension "strategies" were devised for teaching students to employ self-guided methods for improving reading comprehension. In 1969 Anthony V. Reading comprehension is beyond basic literacy alone, which is the ability to decipher

characters and words at all. Reading comprehension relies on two abilities that are connected to each other: word reading and language comprehension. Reading comprehension occurs on a gradient or spectrum, rather than being yes/no (all-or-nothing). The opposite of reading comprehension is called functional illiteracy. In education it is measured in standardized tests that report which percentile a reader's ability falls. Comprehension specifically is a "creative, multifaceted process" that is dependent upon four language skills: phonology, syntax, semantics, and pragmatics.
