Often slope is calculated as a ratio of "rise" to "run", or as a fraction ("rise over run") in which run is the horizontal distance (not the distance along the slope) and rise is the vertical distance. A larger number indicates higher or steeper degree of "tilt". It is a special case of the slope, where zero indicates horizontality 59c2671992
