Impact evaluation In other words, they look for the changes in outcome that are directly attributable to a program. This involves counterfactual analysis, that is, "a comparison between what actually happened and what would have happened in the absence of the intervention. evidence appears, and supports quality impact evaluation through its quality assurance services. In contrast to outcome monitoring, which examines whether targets have been achieved, impact evaluation is structured to answer the question: how would outcomes such as participants' well-being have changed if the intervention had not been undertaken. Another initiative devoted to the evaluation of impacts Impact evaluation assesses the changes that can be attributed to a particular intervention, such as a project, program or policy, both the intended ones, as well as ideally the unintended ones.
