Racial achievement gap in the United States In both fourth-grade reading and eighth-grade math, African American The racial achievement gap in the United States refers to disparities in educational achievement between differing ethnic/racial groups. It manifests itself in a variety of ways: African-American and Hispanic students are more likely to earn lower grades, score lower on standardized tests, drop out of high school, and they are less likely to enter and complete college than whites, while whites score lower than Asian Americans. surpass whites on math and reading tests in all years except third and fourth grade reading 4bfd9ff442

The main approaches to gifted education are enrichment and acceleration. An enrichment program teaches additional, deeper material, but keeps the student progressing through the curriculum at the same rate as other students. For example, after the gifted students have completed the normal work in the curriculum, an enrichment program might provide them with additional information about a subject. An acceleration program advances the student through the standard curriculum faster than normal. This is normally done by having the students skip one to two grades. 4bfd9ff442

Grade inflation However, higher average grades in themselves do not prove grade inflation. The percentage of the population obtaining at least a grade “C” or equivalent in maths, at Grade inflation (also known as grading leniency) is the general awarding of higher grades for the same quality of work over time, which devalues grades.
