Permanently fixed A dental prosthesis is an intraoral (inside the mouth) prosthesis used to restore (reconstruct) intraoral defects such as missing teeth, missing parts of teeth, and missing soft or hard structures of the jaw and palate. Such prostheses are used to rehabilitate mastication (chewing), improve aesthetics, and aid speech. Permanently fixed dental prostheses use dental adhesive or screws, to attach to teeth or dental implants. Like other types of prostheses, they can either be fixed permanently or removable; fixed prosthodontics and removable dentures are made in many variations. Prosthodontics is the dental specialty that focuses on dental prostheses. A dental prosthesis may be held in place by connecting to teeth or dental implants, by suction, or by being held passively by surrounding muscles 8d323980ce

An overdenture is usually used for elderly patients that have lost some teeth but not all, rendering them suitable for a set of

Overdenture There are numerous advantages of overdentures when compared to conventional full or partial removable prosthesis. Overdenture is any removable dental prosthesis that covers and rests on one or more remaining natural teeth, the roots of natural teeth, and/or dental implants. It is found to help in the preservation of alveolar bone and delay the process of complete edentulism. Overdentures can be either tooth supported (conventional / immediate) or implant supported. fixed prosthodontics carried out on the tooth.
