For lip reading, the number of visually distinctive units visemes - is much smaller, thus several phonemes - Lip reading, also known as speechreading, is a technique of understanding a limited range of speech by visually interpreting the movements of the lips, face and tongue without sound. Estimates of the range of lip reading vary, with some figures as low as 30% because lip reading relies on context, language knowledge, and any residual hearing. Although lip reading is used most extensively by deaf and hard-of-hearing people, most people with normal hearing process can infer some speech information by observing a speaker's mouth. concepts

: A key measure in information theory is entropy. Entropy quantifies the amount of uncertainty involved in the value of a random variable or the outcome of a

random process. For example, identifying the outcome of a fair coin flip (which has two equally likely outcomes) provides less information (lower entropy, less uncertainty) than identifying the outcome from a roll... 342ec2a772

In natural language, the readability of text depends on its content (the complexity of its vocabulary and syntax) and its presentation (such as typographic aspects that affect legibility, like font size, line height, character spacing, and line length). For those who do not have high reading comprehension, readability is the ease with which a reader can understand a written text. In programming, things such as programmer comments, choice of loop structure, and choice of names can determine the ease with which humans can read computer program code 342ec2a772

Skylab Designed to enable astronauts to perform untethered Skylab was the United States' first space station, launched by NASA, occupied for about 24 weeks between May 1973 and February 1974. flying the Automatically Stabilized Maneuvering Unit (ASMU) inside the spacious dome of the Orbital Workshop. Skylab's orbit eventually decayed and it disintegrated in the atmosphere on July 11, 1979, scattering debris

across the Indian Ocean and Western Australia. It was operated by three trios of astronaut crews: Skylab 2, Skylab 3, and Skylab 4. Operations included an orbital workshop, a solar observatory, Earth observation and hundreds of experiments. Skylab was constructed from a repurposed Saturn V third stage (the S-IVB), and took the place of the stage during launch
