Functional fixedness For example, if someone needs a paperweight, but they only have a hammer, they may not see how the hammer can be used as a paperweight. The only heavy objects provided were an electrical switch and an electrical relay. The concept of functional fixedness originated in Gestalt psychology, a movement in psychology that emphasizes holistic processing. This "block" limits the ability of an individual to use components given to them to complete a task, as they cannot move past the original purpose of those components. Functional fixedness is this inability to see a hammer's use as anything other than for pounding nails;. Karl Duncker defined functional fixedness as being a mental block against using an object in a new way that is required to solve a problem. Participants were questioned on their choice between the two objects Functional fixedness is a cognitive bias that limits a person to use an object only in the way it is traditionally used 21f623c8b1

Gramme machine Inspired by a machine invented by Antonio Pacinotti in 1860, Gramme was the developer of a new induced rotor in form of a wire-wrapped ring (Gramme ring) and demonstrated this apparatus to the Academy of Sciences in Paris in 1871. A Gramme machine, Gramme ring, Gramme magneto, or Gramme dynamo is an electrical generator that produces direct current, named for its Belgian inventor A Gramme machine, Gramme ring, Gramme magneto, or Gramme dynamo is an electrical generator that produces direct current, named for its Belgian inventor, Zénobe Gramme, and was built as either a dynamo or a magneto. The portion of the winding on the interior of the ring cuts no flux and does not contribute to energy conversion in the machine. Although popular in 19th century electrical machines, the Gramme winding principle is no longer used since it makes inefficient use of the conductors. It was the first generator to produce power on a commercial scale for industry 21f623c8b1
