Deontological ethics is commonly contrasted to utilitarianism and other consequentialist theories, virtue ethics, and pragmatic ethics. In the deontological approach, the inherent rightfulness of actions is considered more important than their consequences. It is sometimes described as duty-, obligation-, or rule-based ethics b6801cd4ff

Moral psychology This field of study is interdisciplinary between the application of philosophy and psychology. Some of the main topics of the field are moral judgment, moral reasoning, moral satisficing, moral sensitivity, moral responsibility, moral motivation, moral identity, moral action, moral development, moral diversity, moral character (especially as related to virtue ethics), altruism, psychological egoism, moral luck, moral forecasting, moral emotion, affective forecasting. Historically, the term "moral psychology" was used relatively narrowly to refer to the study of moral development.
